

## Safety Notice: OSU Corvallis Campus

Safety Notices inform the Oregon State University community of recent incidents regarding personal safety and/or the protection of property. Please read the following information carefully to make informed decisions about your safety and property.

**Content Warning:** This message includes information about property damage that may cause distress. Upon reading this message, if you are in need of supportive care, please reach out to the [Counseling and Psychological Services](#) or the Beyond Benefits Employee Assistance Program. Contact information for each is provided below.

**Time and Location:** The incident occurred at approximately 1:30 a.m. on Feb. 17, 2023, in Callahan Hall, 1420 SW Jefferson Avenue.

**Reported Event:** The Department of Public Safety is investigating a fire that occurred in a communal bathroom within the above residence hall. Bathroom supplies and equipment were damaged, possibly indicating the fire was intentionally set. The fire was already extinguished upon discovery, and there was no damage outside of the bathroom.

Anyone with information about this incident or other criminal behavior occurring within the OSU community is encouraged to call the Department of Public Safety at 541-737-7000 (emergency) or 541-737-3010 (non-emergency). If you or someone else is in immediate danger, dial 911. DPS can connect impacted parties with university and local resources. DPS can also assist university community members with safety planning.

**Response Options and Resources:** The following provides information about university resources and public safety response options. This information is not exhaustive.

- If a member of the Corvallis campus community finds evidence of a fire that has been extinguished, they should immediately notify the Department of Public Safety Dispatch Center to initiate an investigation and document the incident. The dispatch center can be contacted at 541-737-7000 (emergency).
- If you see something, do something. If you don't feel safe intervening directly, find someone who can. If you or someone else is in immediate danger, dial 911.
